Moët & Chandon Imperial Brut

The palate is seductive, combines generosity & elegance, fullness & finesse, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness.

Moët & Chandon Rosé

Lively & generous, distinguishes itself by a radiant colour, an intense fruitiness and flamboyance on the palate.

Moët & Chandon Vintage

A full-bodied, well-structured, delightful Champagne from a classic vintage. The fruit and acidity are perfectly balanced.

2002 £190

Ruinart Blanc de Blanc

Pale yellow hue. Tropical fruit nose. Flavours of apple and lemon with a soda minerality. Pure distinct & clear-cut. Evolves in the mouth, fluctuating between freshness, suppleness & fullness.

Billecart- Salmon Rosé

The aromatic palette is rich & harmonious: sharp gooseberry aromas, give way to mineral & Virginia tobacco notes.

Dom Pérignon

Lovely nose - delicately smoky nuanced toasty notes, slightly reductive and lemony. Beautifully balanced and focused.

Taittinger Comtes de Champagne

Very fruity. The palate is fresh, fine and crisp with citrus fruit and some herby notes. Precision and finesse.

1999 £410

Krug Grande Cuvée

A gleaming gold colour, an extravagantly expansive bouquet, an almost creamy texture.

Cristal Louis Roederer

The overriding impression is one of a true harmony of flavours, senses and silky textures... absolute sensuality.

Krug Rosé

Wild berries - Ginger - Pepper – Quince jelly - Peony - Krug Rosé is a sublime demonstration of the Krug art of blending.

Dom Pérignon Rosé

Generous & sophisticated. Very ripe fruits in the nose, forest strawberries & nectarines, completed by a smoky note.

Moët & Chandon Methuselah

Lively & generous, a bright fruitiness, a seductive palate & an elegant maturity, that continually seduce & delight.

WHITE WINES

Villa Antinori Bianco, Marchesi Antinori	2011	£40
Intense aromatic notes of yellow rose lead to a fresh, medium-bodied palate and a nicely lingering finish.		
Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Broglio	2011	£46
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.		
Leone d'Almerita, Tasca d'Almerita	2011	£48
Pink grapefruit, citrus flowers, white peach and pineapple on the nose, followed by a palate that manages to be both rich and vibrant.		
Vermentino di Bolgheri, Guado al Tasso	2012	£48
This shows the combination of crispness and breadth that marks Vermentino, with engaging citrus flavours and a long mineral finish.		
Pietrabbianca, Tomaresca, Castel del Monte	2011	£55
Full, intense and structured with notes of white peach, ripe apple and vanilla wood on the nose. The palate is powerful yet retains impressive precision and elegance.

Pouilly-Vinzelles, Maison Louis Latour 2009 £65

Pale yellow in color, intense and aromatic bouquet of white peach and fig. Round and bright with a lovely acidity and notes of fresh hazelnuts to finish. This is an elegant wine with impressive structure.

Russiz Superiore Sauvignon Blanc, Marco Felluga 2012 £70

On the nose, there is an intriguing medley of peaches and apricots, sage and thyme, and green bell peppers. In the mouth, freshness and fruitiness make a delightful marriage. The wine is structured and well-balanced, with a silky texture, good body, and a long finish.

Impero Blanc de Pinot Noir, Fattoria Mancini 2010 £105

Impressive and distinctive wine, showing spice from the wood and bright red apple/peach aromas. Broad structure in the mouth, not unlike a Côte de Nuits white – balanced and positive, with a herbal freshness.

Chablis Grand Cru Bougros, Brocard 2010 £115

Mineral on the nose with some slightly burned brioche notes. Elegant and concentrated palate with a lingering finish.

Cervaro della Sala, Marchesi Antinori 2010 £130

Intense, complex aroma with notes of citrus, pear and acacia flowers balanced with a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with sweet notes of butter, hazelnut and mineral.

Chassagne-Montrachet Les Champgainsn 1er Cru F.& L. Pillot 2007 £160

Ripe, expressive nose of flint and yellow fruits. Pure and long with an earthy, mineral backbone. Lovely greengage fruit balances the richness.

RED WINES

Sangiovese, Fattoria Mancini

2011 £48

Juicy, crunchy, appetizing Sangiovese, with flavours of elderberry and mulberry, and a lovely sweetness mid-palate.

Nebbiolo d'Alba Occhetti, Prunotto

2010 £70

This single-vineyard Nebbiolo offers an elegant nose with hints of raspberries and roses. On the palate, it is full and harmonious with a long, positive finish.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, "Santa Pia", La Braccasca

2007

£78

La Braccasca's single-vineyard flagship has ripe red berry fruit and a hint of vanilla. Full, rounded and well-balanced with a sweet, lingering aftertaste.

Sagrantino di Montefalco, Perticaia

2006 £105

A great example of Umbria's signature grape variety, this intense, dramatic wine offers aromas of cinnamon and black cherry, followed by a powerful, structured palate of world-class complexity and balance.

Brunello di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne

2007 £125

Complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish.

Focara Pinot Noir Riserva "Rive", Fattoria Mancini

2011 £130

Rich, resonant Pinot Noir that marries the brightness and elegance of the variety with a blackberry depth rarely encountered outside Burgundy. Purity and concentration combine to give a wine of exceptional vividness.

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Barbaresco Bric Turot, Prunotto

2009 £145

This exceptional single-vineyard Barbaresco is deep and complex on the nose, with hints of liquorice, forest fruits, violets, cinnamon and cloves. On the palate, it is full and well balanced with a persistent finish of ripe fruit.

Vaio Armaron Amarone della Valpolicella, Serego Alighieri

2006 £160

Concentrated and elegant on the nose, with hints of spices and sumptuous ripe red fruit. The velvety palate is dominated by the same notes, with added flavours of wild flowers and herbs. Dry on the finish with excellent length.

Guado al Tasso Antinori

2007 £180

Subtle, fragrant aromas of nuts and mint, alongside rich dark berry fruit. Mouth filling and luxurious, with great ripeness and harmony.

Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Poggio Antico

2004 £190

Hugely impressive, imposing Brunello of profound concentration and focus, with notes of dark fruit, leather and game.

Tignanello Marchesi Antinori

2009 £200

A concentrated Tignanello with ripe red fruit and spice aromas, as well as vanilla and toasty notes from the oak. The palate, while still youthful, is powerful and complex, expressing a great sense of place as well as the ideal weather conditions leading up to the harvest.

Solaia, Marchesi Antinori

2007 £435

Complex fruit aromas with spices, black pepper, chocolate, coffee & vanilla. Generous, vibrant palate with more fruit notes & some minerality. Complex and elegant with a lingering finish.

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Château Musar

1981 £290

Perfect maturity, great vintage (from a year that was poor in France and Italy, so a nice "birthday" wine to have on the list.)

Chateâu Pavie

2006 £435

A dense purple colour as well as an extraordinary perfume of crushed black currants, liquorice, wet stones, and subtle background oak are found in this tannic, dense, masculine-styled 2006. Backward and extraordinarily pure, it is built like a Manhattan skyscraper with exceptional focus, depth, texture, and length.

Vieux Chateâu Certan

2009 £570

The 2009's nearly 14% natural alcohol, exquisite ripeness, and incredible complex bouquet of Asian spices, fruitcake, liquorice, smoke, blackberries and black currants are to die for. A blend of 84% Merlot and the rest equal parts Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, it possesses a viscous texture as well as a freshness and vibrancy that are remarkable given the wine's weight, richness and potential massiveness. This extraordinary effort is one of the finest Vieux Chateau Certans made over the last sixty years.

Chateâu Léoville Les Cases

2005 £580

Notes of toasty vanillin intermixed with lead pencil shavings, wet rocks, and enormously ripe, intense black cherry and crème de cassis. The wine hits the palate with a full-bodied, layered mouth feel as well as enormous extract, concentration, and purity. ...ageless, monumental claret.

Vega Sicilia Unico

1991 £750

The 1991 is a gorgeous, deep ruby/purple-colour, remarkably youthful effort offering sweet vanilla notes intertwined with black currants, cherry liqueur, flowers, spice box, and tobacco leaves. Full-bodied and intense, with sweet tannin, outstanding density as well as purity, and a layered mouth feel.
